Judge Testini was appointed to the bench of the Industrial Commission of Arizona in April 2015. He is a State Bar of Arizona certified workers' compensation specialist. Prior to his appointment, he worked as the senior counsel in charge of the Arizona workers' compensation team at Manning, Kass, Ellrod, Ramirez and Trester, LLC. Prior to practicing defense, he worked as an applicant's attorney for a dozen years, ten of those years at a firm in which he was a founding partner. He coaches moot court and mock trial teams for the Sandra Day O'Connor College of Law at Arizona State University, including teams in the Earle Zehmer Moot Court Competition.

He is a 2010-2011 graduate of the State Bar of Arizona's Bar Leadership Institute, and currently serves on the selection committee. He is also a graduate of the inaugural class of the Collaborative Bar Leadership Academy, and has returned to the program as an instructor. He has served on State Bar of Arizona Committees, such as CLE and Appointments, was a member of the State Bar of Arizona's ER 8.4 Task Force, and chaired the Committee on Minorities and Women in the Law. He has organized several CLE's for the State Bar of Arizona Annual Convention. In 2018 he was appointed to serve on the State Bar of Arizona's Board of Governors.

He served on the Los Abogados Board of Directors for 15 years, the majority of which he has served on the Executive Committee, including two years as the organization's President. He has served on the West Valley Arts Council Board of Directors. He is also an adjunct professor at Grand Canyon University and Arizona Summit School of Law.
